Do you love love?

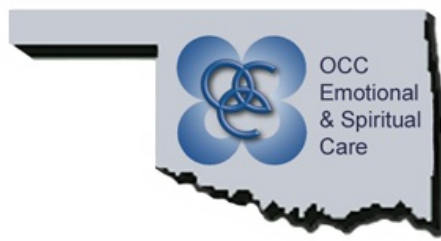
